

General Burns Tennis Ladder – House Rules

Joining the house league is an excellent way to meet and play with same/similar-level members throughout the season. Regardless of your skill level, there will be a place for you in our House Ladder; and don't worry if you don't know your level or you feel you should be in a different House than initially assigned. You can always move to a higher/lower level based on your match results and degree of participation; or through launching a "challenge" against another player.

General

Members in each House will play against other members of their House once during each month and record the results of their matches on the House Ladder Score Sheet posted on the bulletin board (located near the court entrance). Players are responsible for arranging their own matches. The first house league will run to May. 31st.

Scoring

House matches use a pro-set format, with the first to win 8 games by a margin of two or, otherwise a tie-breaker at 7-7. A winner must be decided on every match, as there are no ties. An e-mail will be sent to all players at the beginning of each month indicating the players' placement in each House.

House Membership

At the end of each month, the top two players of each House will be moved up one House, while the bottom two moving down a House. The remaining players stay in the same House for the following month. In case of a tie, the match result between tied individuals will be used to decide placement.

Inactive Players

In fairness to all, any player who fails to play his/her league matches for a one-month period will be removed from the house league; but can join the league again for the following month.
